

## **FREEcycling Chair:**

The Parents' Club collects no-longer needed dorm essentials and school supplies in good condition during dorm move-out in June to distribute to freshmen with highest need.

Popular items include fans, desk lamps, plastic storage bins, bike locks, laundry hampers, luggage, warm coats, notebooks, desk supplies, and more. As students (especially seniors) move out of their dorms for the year, these bulkier items are often left behind. The Parents' Club collects items that are in good condition and stores them for the summer. During our distribution day in the fall, freshmen can select a limited number of items for free. We work with Stanford's Sustainability Office and Stanford's sustainability-themed dorm to collect, store, and distribute items.

Timing:

- Collection occurs over the first two weeks of June and finishes on senior move-out day.
- Distribution occurs on one weekend day in September. Students sign up for an appointment time to come select items.

The club's VP of Student Support oversees this program and will assist and help trouble-shoot along the way as needed.

The Freecycling Chair will also work closely with the club's Textbook & Tools Chair during Collection in the spring. In a parallel effort, the Textbook & Tools Drive Chair collects most-needed textbooks and classroom tools (eg iClickers) for FLIlibrary, a lending library located in the FLI Office.
